## McManamny Club Teams Club Entry Rules

Any affiliated Victorian club may enter between one and five teams.

All Team members must be from the same club. All club members are allowed.

Clubs that enter only one or two teams may combine by mutual agreement to form a 'Combined Club' of three to five teams and be eligible for the CROFTS trophy.

The Event Convenor may combine any remaining club entries into a Combined Club(s)

Clubs must ensure that their entered teams composition complies with the following:

- Teams may consist of 4-6 players
- For each Grand Master, there must be a corresponding player below State Level
- For each Life Master, there must a corresponding player below National level
- Teams of 4 players at or below National Master level are permitted to play together.
- The most experienced pair must play against the most experienced pair from the opposition team.
- If all the players in a team are of the same rank (i.e., National) they may choose who plays with whom.
- Pay the entry fee of \$60 per team before the entry closing date. Clubs may choose to subsidise the entry fees or collect fees from their members.
- Provide the Event Convenor with a spreadsheet of their Club's entries in the following format
